The training fee is a fixed fee to be paid in full, and is based on the season and practice group, and not on the number of practices actually attended. It is refundable in certain situations in accordance with the MAST Member Handbook. \$250 is due at registration, and \$250 or the balance due, whichever is less, is due each following month until all fees are paid in full. If monthly payments are not made, the swimmer may not be allowed to participate in MAST activities. Labor, time, materials, or other services will not be accepted in lieu of payment. The USA-Swimming fee is not refundable.

SWIM MEET FEES AND MEMBER WORK REQUIREMENTS

Each swimmer will be entered into all swim meets, and if a swimmer can not participate, the parent must withdraw the swimmer from the meet by the posted deadline. After the deadline, meet fees must be paid even if the swimmer does not participate in the meet, regardless of the reason. Swim meet fees are variable, depending on the meet and the number of events swum, and will be billed as meets occur.

Members must provide workers for swim meets even if the swimmer does not participate in the meet. In most cases the worker can be anyone 12 or older. A substitute worker can be provided to meet the work requirements. If you do not provide the required number of workers, you must pay \$50 per worker not provided. Year round and summer-only members must provide a total of 5 workers for summer meets as follows: 1 worker at any 2 Dual meets (home or away); 1 worker at the SOSL Invitational (mid June); and 1 worker at 2 sessions, or 2 workers at 1 session at the SOSL Championships (mid July).

MANDATORY CONDITIONS

General Conduct - I agree to abide by the rules imposed by MAST with respect to my swimmer’s eligibility to participate. I agree that my swimmer and all other family members will abide by all MAST rules of conduct and behavior, as stated in the Member Handbook, at MAST activities. I agree that my swimmer and I will be responsible for any MAST or Milford High School property lost or damaged other than fair wear.

General Health - To the best of my knowledge, I declare that my child is physically fit to participate in swimming, and I agree to furnish a doctor’s statement if requested. I agree that MAST does not take responsibility for my child’s physical condition.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless - I agree that MAST, it’s members, coaches, officers, trustees, or designates shall not be liable for any injury or loss which my swimmer or any other family member may sustain while participating in activities of any kind whether sponsored by or under the supervision of the Milford Area Swim Team. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless MAST, it’s members, coaches, officers, trustees, or designates from any claim whatsoever.

OPTIONAL CONSENTS
